EVALUATING DISCIPLESHIP


QUESTIONS TO IDENTIFY PROGRESS:

4. Do adult volunteers view themselves as chaperones or mentors?



EVALUATING PARENT MINISTRY


QUESTIONS TO IDENTIFY PROGRESS:

4. Is there a growing or diminishing desire for parents to be involved?



EVALUATING ADULT VOLUNTEER DEVELOPMENT


QUESTIONS TO IDENTIFY PROGRESS:

4. What is your retention rate among volunteers?



EVALUATING MINISTRY ADMINISTRATION


QUESTIONS TO IDENTIFY PROGRESS:

4. What aspects of ministry administration cause you to feel like you're drowning?



EVALUATING RELATIONSHIP WITH CHURCH LEADERSHIP


QUESTIONS TO IDENTIFY PROGRESS:

4. Are you hiding from church leadership or fully engaged?


