At [Pawleys Island Community Church](#), we wrap who we are around 3 words:

FAMILY – We are His Family
LIFE – We live His Life
PURPOSE – We embrace His Purposes

FAMILY

Many churches say that church is “like” a family. At PICC we say that we ARE a family. Healthy families are places that everyone should feel that they belong. In our Student Ministry we want to create a culture for every student from 6th through 12th grade to belong to so that they can grow in what they believe. Our “family” includes our amazing church staff that serves, not only our church family, but each other as well.

LIFE

We are called, through the power of the Holy Spirit, to live the life of Jesus. In the gospels we see Jesus demonstrate incredible levels of love, so we live lives of love of God and of others. We see Jesus serve, so we serve. We see Jesus give, so we give generously. In our student ministry we want our students to learn that living like Jesus is “normal” not abnormal behavior.

PURPOSE

God created us on purpose and for a purpose. Our students need to be challenged to live life on mission. We were created for the purpose of worship. Our students need to learn to hear the voice of God so that He can direct them daily. Our students need to learn that JOY is part of the overflow of knowing Jesus. Our students should be becoming disciples who in turn make disciples.

The Student Ministry Director/Pastor at PICC:

- Pastor and lead a community of students (6th-12th grades) to become disciples of Jesus Christ.
- Provide pathways for students to make a difference at PICC and our community, not just someday, but today.
- Help educate and equip parents/caregivers to be disciple-makers in their own household.
- The ideal candidate should be an excellent recruiter, team builder and team member.
- Manage well the student ministry budget and resources.
- Plan and execute annual opportunities for students to experience mission work beyond Pawleys Island.
- Communicate effectively with parents to keep them informed about upcoming events and their student's involvement.
- Should have previous experience in student ministry.
- It is helpful to have a college degree or similar training in student ministry.
- Should be an excellent communicator both verbally and in writing.
- Should have a strategy to numerically grow the student ministry to a healthy balance within the PICC family.
- Understanding and execution of PICC values and vision.
- Active participation in the worship services and other events.
- Is a full time/salaried position.
- 40 hours per week with flexibility for evenings and weekend events.
