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
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# STARTING NOW


"Jesus answered, 'I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." John 14:6 (ESV)



# TRUTH DISTORTED



# **INTRO**

Have you ever been amazed by something you've seen or experienced in creation? Maybe it was something as simple as breathing in a fresh spring breeze after a long, cold winter. Or perhaps it was the majesty of a mountain range, the colors of an exotic fish, or the way a puppy squirmed in your arms.

God has clearly shown himself in his creation that humans don't have an excuse to ignore God's power and divinity! We know the truth of God's existence and some of his attributes through creation, and we are to worship him alone. Sadly, many people choose to ignore God and happily worship other things. They exchange "the truth about God for a lie" by worshiping and serving themselves or other created things instead of the Creator. Turning away from God (sin) always leads to destruction.

# DAY ONE

### **SARDINES**

In the game of sardines, only one person hides, and everyone else has to find that person. When a player finds the hider, that player hides with them. Eventually, everyone finds the hider, and at the end of the game, everyone is packed into a space like sardines!

God doesn't play sardines with us. He doesn't say, "I'll hide, and it's going to be really difficult to find me, so good luck!" No, quite the opposite. God makes himself known through his creation! Romans 1:19 says, "For what can be known about God is plain to them, because God has shown it to them." It's so obvious from what we see in nature that God is a powerful, divine being! Just think of the intricacies of a strand of human DNA or the unknown depths of the ocean. Try to imagine the expanse of the universe with way more stars and galaxies than we can count.

"Perhaps the 'futile thinking' of our age is to look inward for a Savior instead of towards Jesus—to say that we can therapize or optimize our sinful and broken natures away. It isn't working, and it isn't going to work. We're still disconnected from each other. We're still yelling at other drivers on the interstate. We're still envious of our neighbor's 'perfect' family. Our hearts are still darkened. Turns out, Jesus is still our true hope."

As we jump into the week, take some time to reflect on these journal questions.
What doubts or questions do you have about creation?
When have you seen God clearly through creation?
What other invisible attributes (besides God's divinity and power) are seen in his creation?
What does it tell you about God that he doesn't hide from us, but evidence of him can be seen?

# DAY TWO

#### CREATOR OF THE UNIVERSE

God is the Creator of the whole universe. This doesn't just include our world or solar system or the Milky Way galaxy or even the tiny percentage of the universe we *can* see—this consists of the estimated hundreds of billions (maybe up to two trillion!) of galaxies that we *can't* see!<sup>2</sup> God is so incredibly mighty that all he has to do is speak, and creation comes into existence! Only a divine being could create things out of nothing by the power of his words. Only God is worthy of our complete worship.

Read **Genesis 1** and use the **Newspaper method** of Bible study to discover all the details. *Approach the passage like a journalist, asking Who? What? Where? When? Why? and How?* 

₩₩○? Make a list of all the major characters in the passage.
WHAT? What is happening in this passage in your own words?

# WHERE? Where is this story taking place? Why is that important? WHEN? What is significant about the timing of this story? What comes before or after that makes this significant? WHY? Why is this story important enough to include in the Bible? HOW? How does this apply to your life? How are you going to live differently today because of what you read? Be specific—a good application will tell who, what, and when.

### DAY THREE

### SURPRESSING THE TRUTH

Have you ever encountered someone so convinced of their position on something that they wouldn't budge even when the evidence showed they were clearly in the wrong? To illustrate with an extreme example, imagine someone convinced that the Earth is flat. They ignore the photos of the round earth from the international space station, the round shadow seen during a lunar eclipse, or even the fact that we can only see so far into the distance on earth (but can still see stars that are light years away with our naked eye), suggesting that the earth curves because things are eventually out of sight. You show them the evidence and have them observe for themselves, yet they are still set in their ways and refuse to admit they might be wrong. They suppress the truth that the Earth is, in fact, round!

On the left side of the space provided, write all the things that Romans 1:18–25 says about those who suppress the truth—list what they did. Then, on the right side, write down how the wrath of God was shown against these sins. There are real consequences for suppressing the truth and embracing a lie instead!

# DAY FOUR

### LOVING AND SERVING GOD FIRST

Do you sometimes feel like there's a tug-of-war game going on in your soul? One side is pulling We are made in God's image and created to be in a right relationship with him. However, our worship often is misdirected to ourselves, the created thing, rather than the Creator! Sometimes our idols are physical things like our phone, money, or even our significant other. But often, our idols are invisible, internal. Many people unknowingly worship themselves by seeking comfort, acceptance from peers, or recognition for their accomplishments more than giving God his rightful praise, love, and service. God desires and is worthy of our worship. He deserves to be the most important in our lives!

"Each of us has a battle raging within us over what we love most—God or something else. Whenever we love or serve anything in place of God, we're engaging in idolatry. . . . . We think having [idols] will truly satisfy us. We think they're worthy of our worship. Of course, we're wrong. . . . Idols are all around us. . . . Material comforts Financial security. Sensual pleasures. . . Things like reputation, power, and control." – Bob Kauflin<sup>3</sup>

# DAY FIVE

### **IGNORING GOD**

If a child has a bucket of Halloween candy, their parents might talk to them about being careful with how much they eat at a time to avoid the risks of getting stomachaches or even sick from eating too much. But if the child ignores their parents and insists on eating a huge pile of candy, the parents might let this happen so that the child learns the natural consequences of too much sugar at one time. The child knew what their parents said but ignored their instruction. Similarly, many people, even though they know what God has said and know that death is the consequence of sin without repentance, refuse to acknowledge God, insist on their own way, and lean into their sins.


Study the verses in **Romans 1:28–32** carefully using the **OPA method** for Bible Study: Observation, Principles, and Application. *Helpful tip: the more effort you put into making observations, the easier the principles and application will be to see.* 

#### OBSERVATION

Compile all the facts found in the passage. Try to make 10–15 observations about what you read.

### PRINCIPLES

Draw a few principles from the observations you made. What is God trying to teach you in this passage?
APPLICATION
How will you apply these principles to your life? Be specific—a good application will tell who, what, and when.



### GLORY OF THE IMMORTAL GOD

You've probably experienced going from a dark room or building out into the sunlight. You feel momentarily blinded, and to protect your eyes, you instinctively close or shield them. God's glory is like that, but on an infinitely larger scale. As we read the Bible, the topic of his glory comes up quite a bit. It is both fearful (awe-inspiring and profound) and also amazing and beautiful. Romans 1:23 makes it clear that those who worship things other than the immortal (living forever, never dying) God essentially toss aside God's glory and settle for things much, much lesser.

Find these verses in your Bible and write what you discover about God's glory.
